

SCHOOL PROGRAMS

Your membership fee helps cover the oversight of school programs and help provide materials such as activity books, awards for teachers and school trainings, as well as fuel needed for tricycles to pick up recyclable materials.



WASTE PICKER SUPPORT

Environment360 supports waste pickers by providing them a variety of tailored training to help them build better businesses. Your membership fees help cover materials for trainings, facilitators and ongoing business support.



GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE FEES

Did you know Environment360 does not have core funding? As a result, your membership fees help keep the bills paid and the lights on! Membership fees have created employment opportunities for 8 young Ghanaian workers.

CASH ON HAND TO PURCHASE MATERIALS

Environment360 believes in creating an inclusive environment. In order to help raise the living wages of waste pickers we need cash on hand to readily buy materials from waste pickers. Owing to this, Environment360 needs to keep an estimated GHS 20,000 of cash on hand to freely purchase materials as they are made available from community members.

1. Who is Environment360?

Environment360 is an Accra based non-governmental organization that supports sustainable environments through the creation of recycling programs, education of school children in coastal and urban areas, and support of waste pickers.

2. How often are pickups?

Pickups are done based on the membership level you choose. Please refer to your desired membership level. Note, extra charges do apply for additional pick-ups.

3. WHAT AREAS ARE PICKUPS AVAILABLE?

Pick-ups are available in the Greater Accra Region. Currently, E360 does not service Teshie, Weija, or Nsawam areas. If you are unsure if you fall within a service region please call or email.

4. WHERE DO PICKED UP WASTE GO?

Flexible packaging and hard plastics are sold on the local market, while PET is sold to a third party that exports to Germany. Paper is sold locally and made into egg crates and toilet paper.

5. WILL I BE PAID WHEN MY RECYCLABLES ARE PICKED UP?

Environment360 offers a buy back scheme of .05 pesewas per kilogram for your plastic waste. Money is aggregated and paid out yearly to each client. Monies can be used towards another membership fee or donated back to Environment360.

6. CAN INDIVIDUALS JOIN?

Yes can individuals can join! There are different types of membership packages available for both communities and businesses.

7. WHAT ARE MY BENEFITS AS A MEMBER?

Benefits vary based on what level of membership you choose. Please refer to our package to see which membership best suits you.

8. WHAT TYPES OF PLASTICS ARE COLLECTED?

Environment360 collects all plastics. However,

plastics must be clean and free from stains such as oil, food and dirt. Stained plastics may be rejected by the logistics team.

9. How is membership money used?

Membership money is used to help cover administrative costs, support of waste pickers and our school programs.

10. How does you organization raise funds?

We raise funds through memberships, sales of recyclables and partner projects.

11. WHAT TYPES OF ACTIVITIES ARE HELD IN YOUR EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM?

Children take part in interactive and fun activities like environmental excursions, class seminars, competitions, Hands on activities like planting in bottles etc. To enable them explore, discover and learn more about their environment.

12. CAN I DONATE MORE?

Yes you can! You are welcome to donate more to support our school program.

13. DO CORPORATE MEMBERS PAY THE SAME FEE EVERY YEAR?

Once a corporate members signs up for Environment360 their annual donation is just GHS 500 for each successive year. Individual memberships are renewed at the same rate.

14. Do you collect only plastics?

No, we also pickup all types of paper that are free from stains such as oil and food.

15. How do I pay in my donation?

You pay your donation with cash or cheque at our office, through MTN mobile money on number 0244 669 851 or through our Fidelity bank account.
